    - i. Ask people to illustrate aspects of your nominee's contributions to the community that are different from the ones you wrote about in the nomination form.
  - c. Please do not submit additional materials other than those requested. Resumes and articles are not required.
2. Submit nomination and support forms to YWCA Lancaster by **5:00 p.m. on July 19, 2019** via email to [seberly@ywcalancaster.org](mailto:seberly@ywcalancaster.org) or drop off a printed copy at 110 North Lime Street, Lancaster. No exceptions to this deadline will be made.
